#### Actions/accomplishments

- The Leadership in Athletics Committee, as appointed by the AMA Board, organized the inaugural event in the Mullin/Elmore Leadership in Athletics endowed speaker series. Boston Marathon Champion Desiree Linden spent the day at S&T on November 13, 2021. The general public, S&T students, varsity athletes and staff, local multi-sport clubs, area high school athletic teams were invited. Des held a meet and greet at Allgood Bailey stadium, ran a fun run with 30 participants, held a meet and greet in the S&T Hall of Fame room for special guests, and gave a keynote speech entitled "Keep Showing Up: The Importance of Consistency" to approximately 200 persons in the audience.


